Wilson's Warbler







Wilson's Warbler, *Wilsonia pusila*, is one of the most numerous warblers in western North America and is easily identified by the male's black cap. It spends wintertime in the highlands of Central America then migrates north in spring to mate and nest in the Pacific Northwest, Canada and Alaska. It prefers habitats with dense ground cover in riparian areas where its insect prey abound.
