She has traveled to teach and sketch wildlife from the Alaskan arctic tundra to the South American Andes, the rainforests of Borneo to Mediterranean islands. At the pandemic's onset, Christine began sharing her passion for wildlife conservation through nature journaling with a global audience and has since taught over 200 live, online workshops.
